- Following five consecutive once-a-week training sessions, Sea Rangers will apply their skills in helping protect the tidepools at Point Fermin State Marine Park, the shoreline along Cabrillo Beach and the adjacent saltmarsh.
- Volunteers are requested to participate in 6 hours of scheduled weekend activities per month. Periodic enrichment training will provide an opportunity for participants to continue learning and to share their experience.
- Training is from 4 to 6pm on five consecutive Thursdays: April 28, May 5, 12, 19 & 26. A parent/guardian of minors is required to attend a 30 minute orientation held at the beginning of the first session.
