Great White Shark/Richard Ellis, John E. McCosker. **QL638.95 .L3 E45**

This book has been described as "the definitive account of shark-observing adventures." Richard Ellis's paintings and extraordinary photographs by Al Giddings and others are included in this comprehensive volume.

The Secret Life of Sharks/A. Peter Klimley, Ph.D **QL638.9 .K57 2003**

The author, a marine biologist, was one of the first scientists to free-dive among sharks. Read his first-hand observations on this fascinating animal.

Shadows in the Sea: the sharks, skates and rays/Harold W. McCormick, [et al.]. **QL638.6 .M3 1963**

A fine writing team headed by McCormick, have searched throughout the world for information on sharks.

The Shark/Jacques-Yves Cousteau, Philippe Cousteau. **QL638.9 .C6613**

Cousteau and his son blend narrative text and full-color photographs to underline a great, exotic adventure in studying the shark and its world of beauty and danger.

Shark Life/Peter Benchley. **QL638.9 .W64 2005**

Master storyteller Benchley has compiled an adventurous and informative guide to the sea with an array of sharks and other marine animals he and his family have encountered.

The author is an Australian scuba diver and is trying to find a means of preventing shark attacks on humans, without destroying the balance of marine ecology.
