Blue Whale: largest whale in the world can get about 100ft long, its favorite food is **krill**

Grey Whale: a mud sucking whale that eats a lot of **amphipods**, small crustaceans found in the mud

Finback Whale: second largest baleen whale can reach about 66ft, it gets its name from the fin on its back near its tail

Baleen: this hair like material, made from keratin that makes up our hair and finger nails, that replaces teeth in certain whales like the blue whale, grey whale, **finback** whale, **humpback** whale, **minke** whale, **right** whale, **sei** whale, **bryde's** whale, and many more

Dolphin family: here are the animals in this word search that are in the dolphin family; **common** dolphin, **bottlenose** dolphin, **orca** (killer whale), **risso** dolphin, **pacific white sided** dolphin, and **false killer** whale

Spyhop: a behavior that whales do when they come out of the water, take a look around, and then go back under water

Breach: another behavior that whales do, when the whale jumps out of the water, turns on its side, and makes a huge splash

Fluke: a whale tail is also known as a fluke
