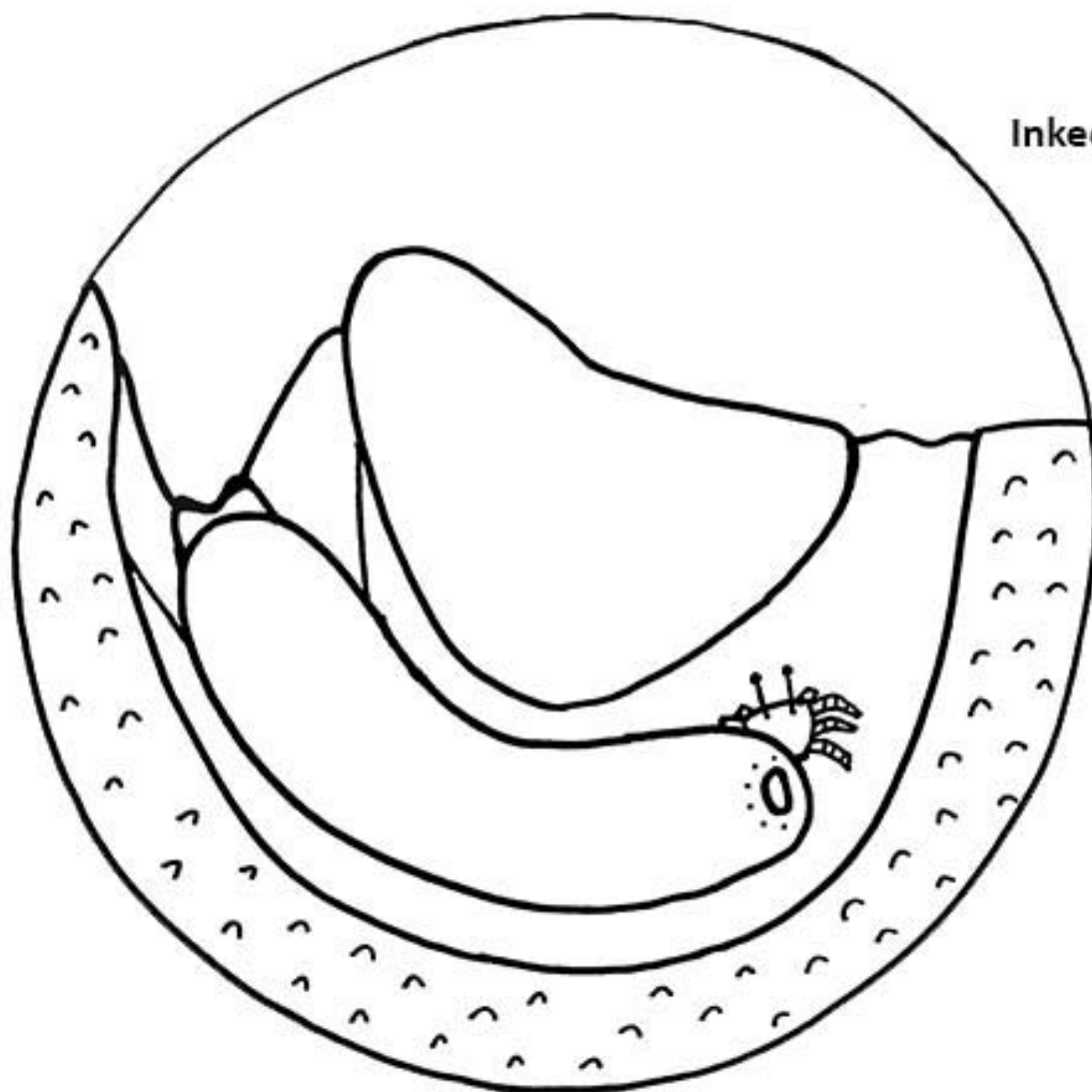


Under the mud...
