Learn how to identify different species of whales by comparing their blows and discover what common behaviors to look for...

Materials:

- 1 Whale observation sheet
 - Side 1: Thar she blows!
 - Side 2: Whale behaviors
- ½ sheet blank paper (to make sliding cover)
- 1 brad
- Coloring pencil/pens/crayon
- Scissors
- Glue

How to:

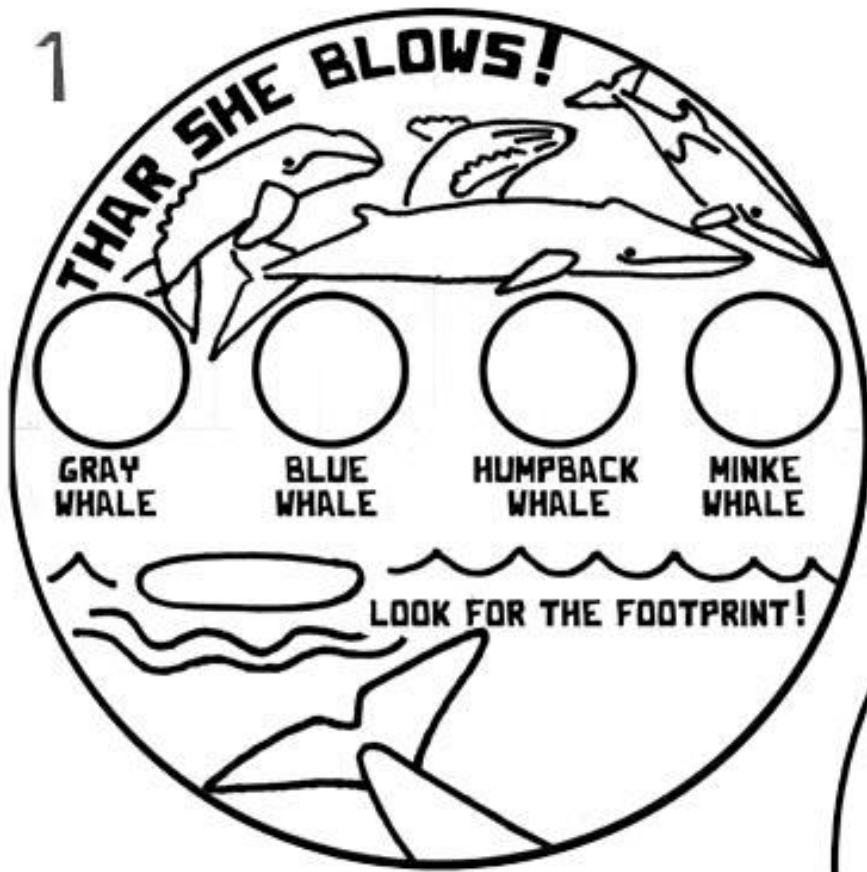
- Research and...
 - Draw in blows for different species of whale on side 1
 - Label different whale behaviors on side 2
- Color and cut out side 1 + 2
- Trace and cut out blank circle,
- Cut window by removing ¼ of circle minus near the center...
 - Leave small corner intact to have space for the brad to go in...
- Place blank circle over side 2 and poke brad thru the center of both
- Glue the edges of side 1 over the back of side 2
 - The brad should be covered but still able to spin

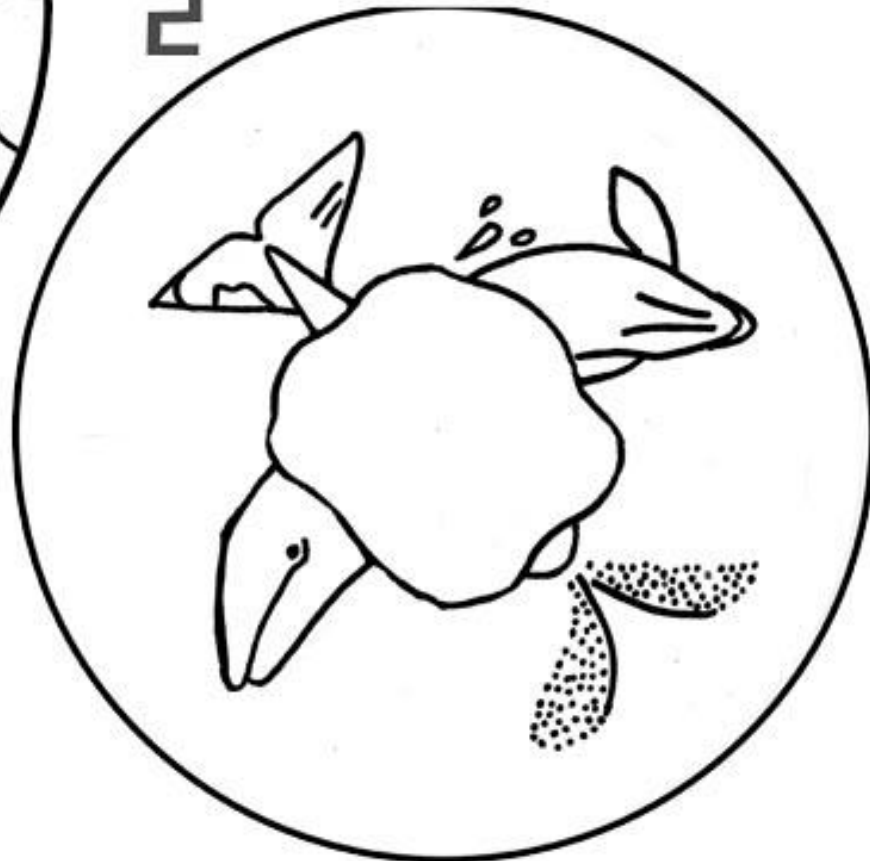
