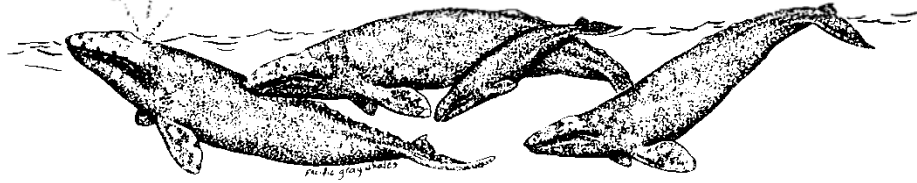


LET'S GO WHALE WATCHING!

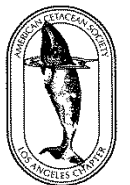
