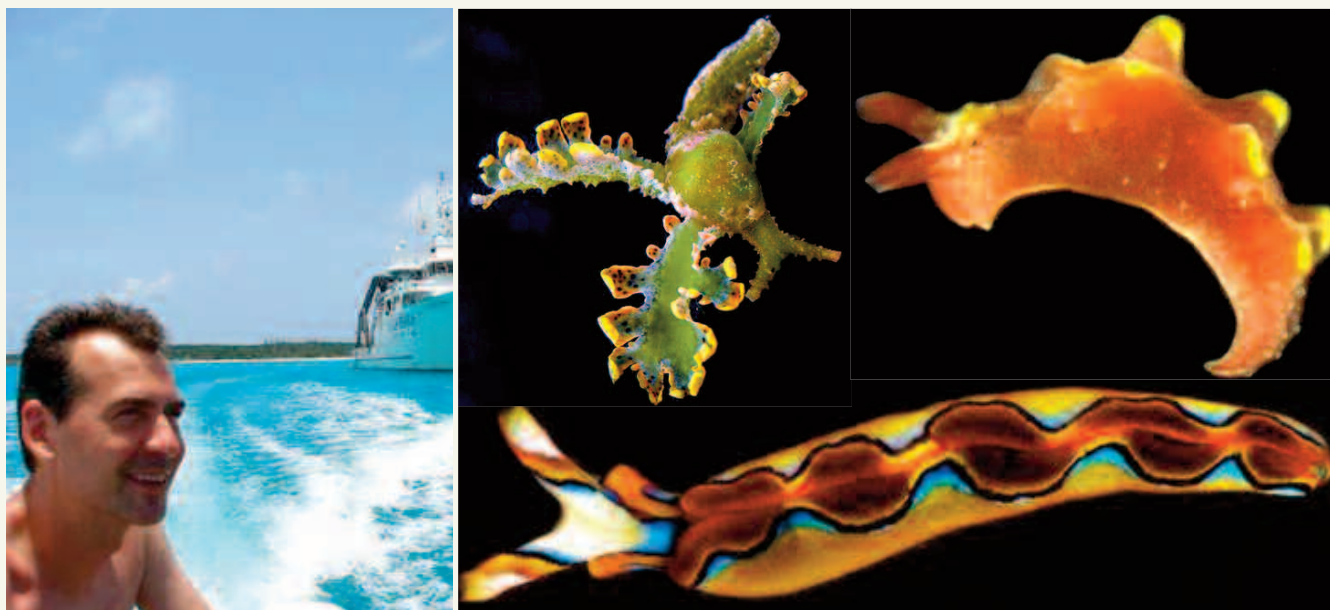

Sea slugs are among the most spectacularly beautiful animals in the world, but what can explain how such stunning colors and patterns evolved among vulnerable, shell-less creatures in an ocean full of hungry predators? We will explore the many ways in which sea slugs specialized to feed on prey that most other consumers reject. Come learn how these vivid molluscs recycle aspects of their prey to their own benefit - becoming toxic, stinging, or photosynthetic.
