Vaquitas are down to the last few individuals of a species that has lived in the Gulf of California for 3 million years. The problem seems easy, ban gillnets and the species is saved. The solution has proven too hard. This talk summarizes what happened with vaquita conservation and considers what hope remains and what could be done differently next time.



Dr. Barbara Taylor has been researching marine mammals for over 30 years. She works at the Southwest Fisheries Science Center in La Jolla, California.
