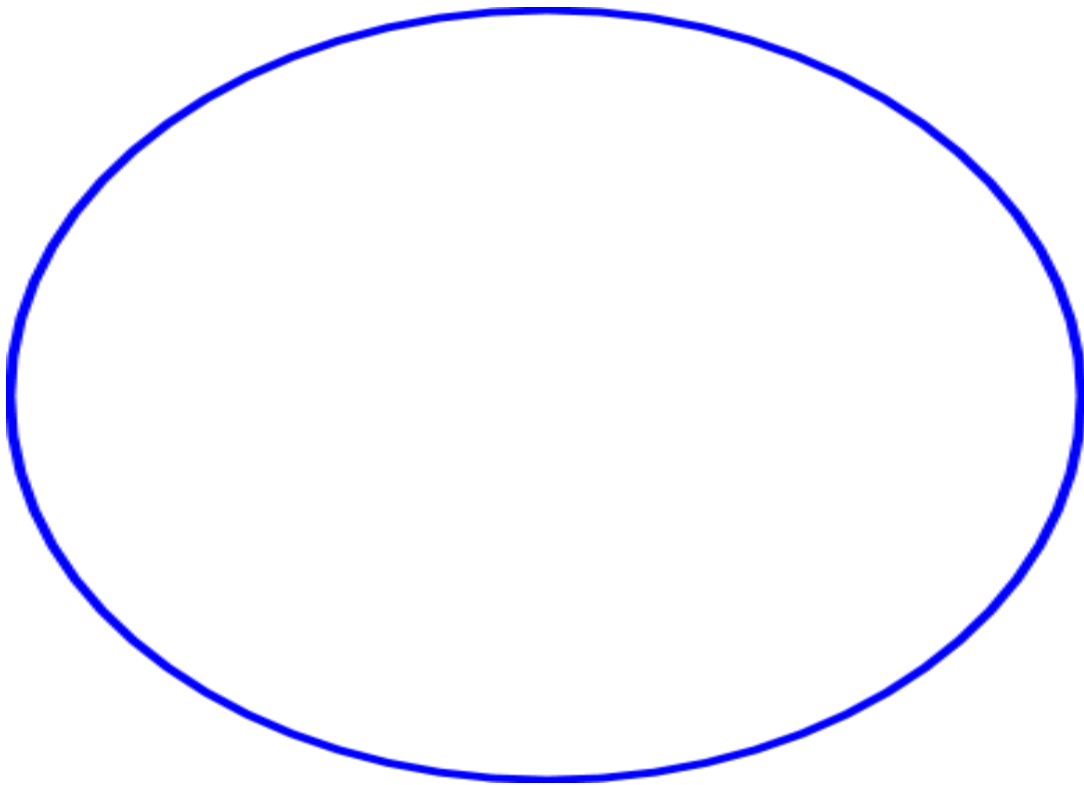

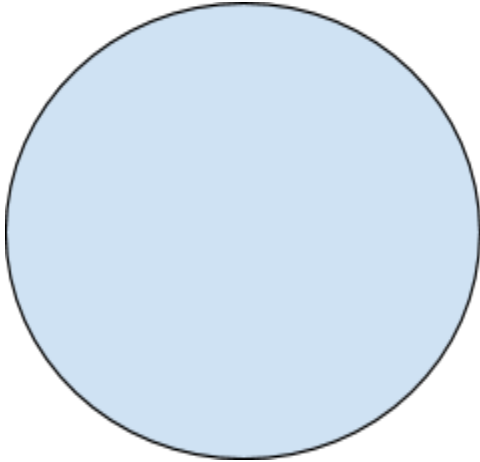
CAN YOU DRAW OR DESCRIBE HOW THE SAND CRAB EATS?

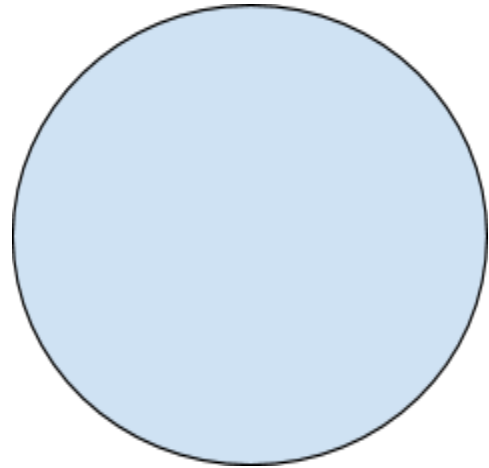
IMAGINE YOU'RE LOOKING AT ONE PART OF THE ANIMALS BODY THROUGHT A MICROSCOPE

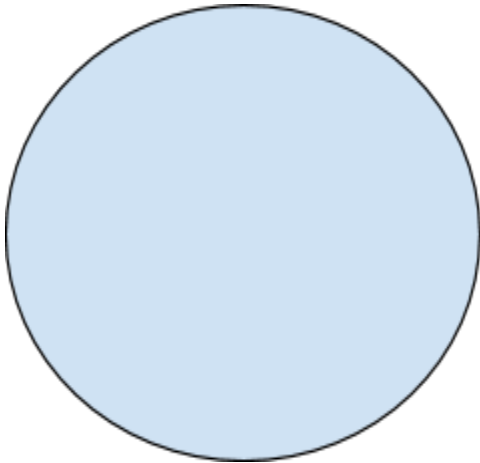
ANTENNA



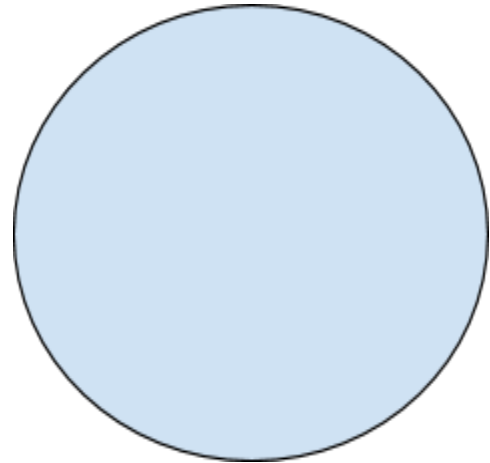
CRAB EYES
