## Materials:

- Cardboard/Thick paper
- Pencil/Pen/Paint (optional)
- Scissors
- Glue/tape
- Stick

## How to:

- Choose your favorite whale, behavior, or blow
- Draw outline on cardboard, color, paint, decorate!
- Let dry
- Use scissors to carefully cut out shape
- Glue or tape stick (or folder cardboard) to the back
